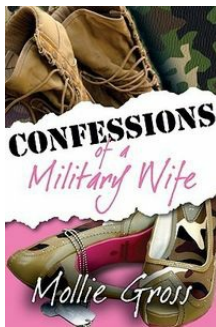


CONFESSIONS OF A MILITARY WIFE
