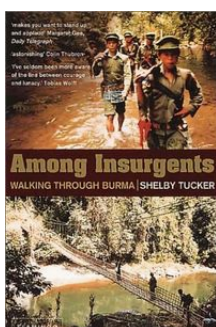


AMONG INSURGENTS: WALKING THROUGH BURMA
