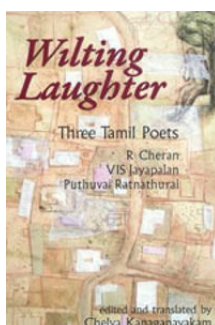


WILTING LAUGHTER: THREE TAMIL POETS
