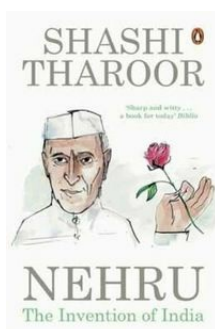


NEHRU: THE INVENTION OF INDIA
