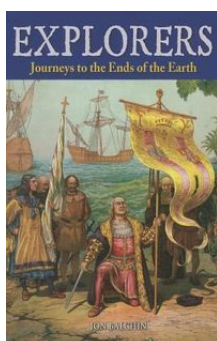


# EXPLORERS: JOURNEYS TO THE ENDS OF THE EARTH
