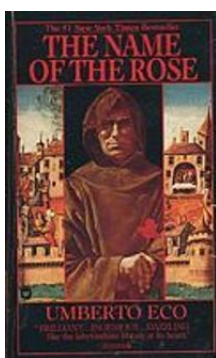


THE NAME OF THE ROSE
